

## Matters Arising from Amenities and Open Spaces April 2026

- **Drainage on the Kings Field and Memorial Field**  
Two further quotations are awaited from the football club for the spring renovation work, then an application for s106 funds can be made to HDC.
- **Works Officer storage containers**  
Awaiting response from UKPN on whether supply can be upgraded to allow fast EVC.
- **Bus voucher scheme**  
A response is awaited from Stagecoach regarding the updated number of houses.
- **Active Travel**  
Detailed design work will take place 2026/27. In terms of s106 the scheme is contractually committed through the design stage before the spending by deadline (in 2026/27). WSCC have confirmed the intention is to use the remaining amount for construction the following financial year.
- **Skate Park**  
Proposals for the skate park has not yet been finalised.
- **Wider path to leisure centre**  
Installation likely to take place May half term. Confirmation awaited.
- **Bishop Lane planting beds**  
Stonepit nursery have been instructed to carry out agreed improvements however consideration needs to be given to watering for new turf and planting.
- **Toad sculpture**  
The toad is still with the Shedders drying out.
- **Public conveniences**  
The usual cleaner has now returned to work.
- **Lighting at the Primary School**  
Investigation into why lights are on all night is ongoing.
- **Bysshop Meadow**  
A meeting date has been requested
